

NOTIFICATION FOR COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

According to the Law on Personal Data Protection (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia”, No. 87/2018-furthermore Law) and in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (furthermore GDPR), Institute for Philosophy and Social Theory, University of Belgrade (furthermore IPST), Kraljice Natalije 45, Belgrade, acts as data controller, intends to collect and process your personal data collected through the registration form (subsequently referred to as: “Data”).

The purpose of collecting and processing Data is sending information of the IPST activities. Therefore, IPST informs the party from whom the data is collected about the following:

1. IPST collects and processes Data exclusively for the purpose of sending information of the IPST activities, based on the prior consent of the person whose Data are being collected. These Data will be used for the period of consent. IPST will not use the collected Data for any other purposes, disclose them to other parties or misuse them in any other manner.
2. IPST collects Data based on the informed consent related to Data.
3. IPST stores Data in its internal databases with all organizational, personnel and technical protection measures included.
4. IPST may also provide Data to third parties. Who may have access to the Data:
 - companies that maintain the information systems of the Controller where the Data is stored.
5. The person whose Data is collected and processed has the following rights:
 - the right to request access to personal data and information related to processing from the Controller;
 - the right to rectification;
 - the right to erasure;
 - the right to restriction of processing;
 - the right to data portability;
 - the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling;
 - the data subject shall have the right to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her
 - the right to be informed;
 - right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
 - Right to an effective judicial remedy against a controller or processor;
 - other rights guaranteed by the Law and GDPR.



The person whose Data is collected and processed may exercise his / her rights by sending a request to the Controller. The Controller will provide with all necessary additional information, as well as assistance, in accordance with the conditions and in the manner prescribed by the Law and GDPR.
