

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

THE INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL “WATERSCAPES in HERITAGE and ENVIRONMENT” Croatia 1-7 JUNE 2024

Organized by the University of Bergamo (MA in Planning and Management of Tourism Systems), the University of Belgrade (Institute for Philosophy and Social Theory) and the University of Milan Bicocca (Department of Human Sciences for Education).

The Summer School “**WATERSCAPES in HERITAGE and ENVIRONMENT**” addresses the issues of sustainability in tourism and in the management of cultural and natural heritage with the methodology of action-research, proposing an intensive week of seminars, visits, and group works, developed along the agreed maritime itinerary.

The visits and seminars of the Summer School explore the main core themes:

1. Archeology and Material Heritage
2. Social and Historical implications of Tourism
3. Sustainability, Environment, Biodiversity Education and Sea Cultures

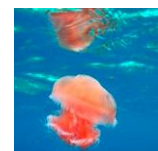
The applicants to the Summer School “**WATERSCAPES in HERITAGE and ENVIRONMENT**” are PhD and Master Students regularly enrolled in their home institutions for the year 2023-2024, attending courses referring to at least one of the three core themes of the Summer School.

The Summer School starts on the 1st and finishes on the 7th of June 2024, departing/arriving from Zadar, Croatia. The selected participants are required to attend the entire Summer School and all related didactic and training activities.

The Summer School “**WATERSCAPES in HERITAGE and ENVIRONMENT**” takes place on board a dedicated boat, specifically chosen and chartered by the organizers. The participation fee is € 300.00, to be paid in cash upon arrival. The participation fee includes:

- 6 nights on the boat, in a double cabin with a bathroom,
- 6 breakfasts and 6 lunches,
- Daily seminars related to the three themes of the Summers School,
- Daily educational excursions introduced and guided by international experts,
- Group work related to the topics presented and to the visits carried out.
- Certificate of attendance issued by the University of Bergamo.

The fee does not include travel expenses to/from Croatia, dinners, drinks, and other personal expenses.



How to apply

The application form contained in this call must be filled in, accompanied by a CV and a motivational letter and addressed to the email contacts listed below, specifying in the subject "The Summer School WATERSCAPES in HERITAGE and ENVIRONMENT".

The deadline for the application is **March 31st, 2024 at 12.00.**

Admission process

The candidates will be evaluated by a Commission which includes the Coordinators of the activity, Prof. Bougleux (University of Bergamo) and Dr. Iguman (University of Belgrade), and members of the Scientific Committee as representatives of the thematic areas of the Summer School. The admission criteria will consider the following:

- Academic and Professional curriculum;
- Language skills: proven knowledge of English (minimum C1).

It is also required to write a Motivational Letter, in which the candidate explains one's personal motivation to participate in this Summer School.

Admitted students must confirm their willingness to participate by writing to the local contact person and to the official email of the Summer School within one week of the notification of admission.
